**Purpose:** Protection of company premises against intruders

**Legitimate interests pursued:** Protection of property and personal safety of staff and visitors, subsequent preservation of evidence through recording, protection against burglary and theft

**Rechtsgrundlage der Datenverarbeitung:** Art 6(1)(f) of the GDPR

**Notes on the rights of data subjects:** The data subject has the right to obtain from the controller confirmation as to whether or not personal data concerning him or her are being processed, and, where that is the case, access to the personal data and to the information detailed in Art. 15 of the GDPR. The data subject has the right to obtain from the controller without undue delay the rectification of inaccurate personal data concerning him or her and, where appropriate, to have incomplete personal data completed (Art. 16 of the GDPR). The data subject has the right to obtain from the controller the erasure of personal data concerning him or her without undue delay where one of the grounds detailed in Art. 17 of the GDPR applies, for example if the data are no longer necessary in relation to the purposes sought (right to erasure). The data subject has the right to obtain from the controller restriction of processing if one of the criteria listed in Art. 18 of the GDPR is met, for example if the data subject has objected to processing, for the duration of the review by the controller. The data subject has the right to object, on grounds relating to his or her particular situation, at any time to processing of personal data concerning him or her. The controller shall in this case no longer process the personal data unless the controller demonstrates compelling legitimate grounds for the processing which override the interests, rights and freedoms of the data subject or for the establishment, exercise or defense of legal claims (Art. 21 of the GDPR). Without prejudice to any other administrative or judicial remedy, every data subject has the right to lodge a complaint with a supervisory authority if the data subject considers that the processing of personal data relating to him or her infringes the GDPR (Art. 77 of the GDPR). The data subject can exercise this right by lodging a complaint with a supervisory authority in the Member State of his or her habitual residence, his or her place of work or the place of the alleged infringement.
